Know your ASIC



A valid red or grey Aviation Security Identification Card (ASIC) must be properly displayed while in a security-controlled airport or airside security zone.

What to look for:

Does the photo match the person?

Is the expiry date valid?

Is it attached to the front or side of outer clothing, above waist height?

Check for tampering, alterations or damage.

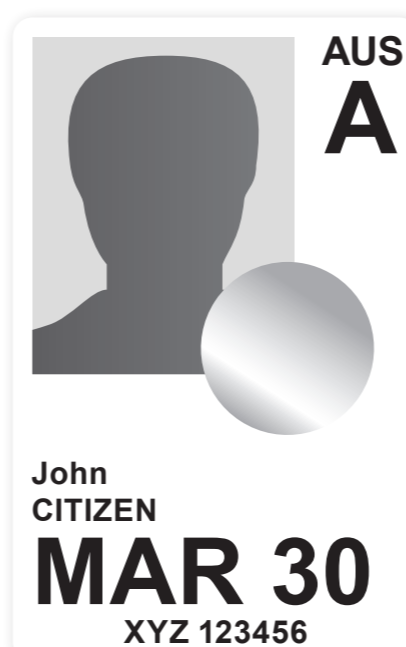
